Dear Students and Parents,

In order to assist Valley Central seniors pursuing education after high school, the Valley Central Scholarship Council has established the following criteria for the selection of its scholarship recipients.

- 1. Demonstration of a seriousness of academic purpose.
- 2. Participation in school activities as circumstances permit.
- 3. Participation in community activities including outside employment.
- 4. Demonstration of reliability and dependability, i.e. good attendance and the fulfillment of commitments.
- 5. Consideration of financial need.

Scholarships will be available for all types of higher education, academic and vocational (i.e. cosmetology, auto mechanics, computers, secretarial science, etc.) The financial requirements of the school at which you have been accepted will also be taken into consideration. In the event that your financial need is nearly or fully met, scholarships may still be awarded to recognize your accomplishments.

#### The application consists of three parts:

**Application form:** Please be sure that all items are answered and that you include school and community activities in which you have participated. You can use the back of the application form if additional space is needed and **do not** include resumes, certificates or any other backup documentation. Be sure that both you and your parents sign the application.

**Student Essay:** Your essay must accompany your application or you will not be considered for a scholarship. It must be typed using Standard English and not include your name. Use one side of each sheet only. Your essay should be at least 200 but no more than 300 words. The selection committee considers each essay very carefully. Please compile an essay that focuses on the following topic: **During your time at VC, describe an act of kindness that you witnessed or performed. Share how this experience impacted or inspired you.** 

**Financial Statement:** To be completed by the applicant and his/her parents or guardians. Be sure that all items are answered. *Please Note: In order to not compromise the confidentiality of your financial statement, only the high school principal and the Director of Guidance will view this portion.* The financial statement will be separated from your application and essay.
